Job Title: Mathematics Teacher Degree Apprenticeship

- Reports to: Head of Maths
- Salary: Unqualified Teacher Scale

Key Responsibilities

- Work with staff members from across the school, in a range of roles, to become a developing practitioner with a broad knowledge base of the impact those roles have on pupil development and relationships with the wider community.
- Plan and prepare well-structured, clearly presented sessions appropriate to the abilities of all students and the syllabus being taught, in line with the requirements of the current phase of the Teacher Degree Apprenticeship
- Make sure that the classroom is a stimulating environment that facilitates learning
- Generate enthusiasm for the subject being taught and work creatively to inspire all students to work to their potential
- Liaise with the Head of Department, mentors and relevant staff members, including where a student may have special educational needs and if a student is experiencing pastoral difficulties
- Promote high standards of behaviour by encouraging a positive, proactive approach to studying and build productive relationships with students
- Where appropriate, set homework that aligns to the student's ability and their wider workload, in accordance with School policy
- Assess student's work accurately and regularly, giving thoughtful and meaningful feedback.
- Promote high standards of organisation
- Improve, update and maintain materials and resources as needed
- Where appropriate, complete written assessments and reports according to guidelines and deadlines
